Temporary faculty employed during the prior academic year (2016/17) who have completed six years of prior consecutive service shall be offered a three-year temporary appointment following satisfactory evaluations, pursuant to Article 15 of the Unit 3 Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA). The entitlement time base for a three-year appointment is determined by the total WTUs taught in 2016/17, unless a temporary faculty member worked full time. If full time in the prior year, the entitlement time base of the 3-year appointment is based upon the work available in the first year of the three-year appointment.
